A sleek, low profile Relative Motion Orthosis. Relative motion made extremely simple.



Relative motion is a technique which places one or more fingers in a relatively extended or flexed position compared to the others.

Allows the entire hand to stay functional while achieving treatment objectives.

Designed as a ready-to-use alternative to thermoplastics.

Formed by a metallic band with a smooth silicone finish, and a locking tab on each end.

Waterproof, UV coating protects the outer surface and ensures long-term patient comfort.

Indications include:

Extensor tendon/sagittal band repair, PIP extension or flexion contracture, boutonniere deformity, trigger finger, Dupuytren's disease, tendon adhesions, digit pain/stiffness.
